Our pre-k program provides a smooth transition to kindergarten.



Science teaches children to observe, question, and draw conclusions based on experiences; i.e. they may not be able to understand that the volume of water does not change by pouring it into another container that appears to hold more.

Saxon math is a teaching method for incremental learning of mathematics. It involves teaching a new mathematical concept every week and constantly reviewing old concepts.

Motor Skills, outdoor play with hoops, bean bags, balance beams, bicycles and other large motor equipment challenges the children's sensory perception to form an understanding for concepts and experiences.

Chapel time, our Bible curriculum gives the children the opportunity to grow in their faith and relationship with God, which includes weekly chapel lead by Pastor Ray.

Language Development is enhanced with our curriculum of Zoo Phonics The principle of Zoo-phonics® maximizes understanding, memory, utilization and transference to all areas of the reading, spelling and writing process in a playful and concrete manner.

Art, music, and dramatic play are a daily part of the program. It gives children an important opportunity for creative expression and to develop rhythm and movement.
